- ⇒ To join the MSDNAA agreement you need to fill the registration form and hand it out to Scientific Computation Center (SCC), Computer and Systems Engineering Department. The SCC is at Faculty of Engineering, the Administration building (3<sup>rd</sup> floor) (Telephone no. 5919682).
